- Please turn all irrigation water off 24 hrs before the scheduled start date.
- Water should remain off until 24 hrs after each phase is competed unless specified.
- Delineators will be dropped off with "NO PARKING" signs and placed at entries and areas of visibility to notify patrons of the work being completed.
- Please notify all Tenants/residents of the work being completed. TMC can draft a notice with a map at your request.
- Depending on the weather, seal coat typically drys quickly if its sunny/warm out. Please Do not open areas up until our "TMC" representative has been notified.
- The material will look flat black when dry and may be walkable if needed. Although not recommended, please avoid areas that look shiny or wet.
- Striping crew will show up the evening of Seal Coat completion or the following day, this is all depending on how the areas is drying and availability on crews timing.
- Once phase(s) of work have been completed a TMC representative will open all area(s) to allow foot and vehicle traffic to pass.
- Marring/Tear-ups: please note that seal coat is a material with sand and will tear up if a car turn their wheels
 while on a stopped motion. This is normal and will blend in.
