TREASURER'S REPORT

Joe Bulfer reported that the Association's total assets were 3.1 million dollars.

- Approve Check to Pro-Tech Paint for \$46,800.00 from reserve account.
- Approve Check to Farmers Insurance (Liability Ins) for \$14,939.49 from operational account
- Approve Check to TMC for \$160,900 from reserve account.

MANAGER'S REPORT

Bill updated the Board and residents on the progress of the painting, siding, maintenance and solar projects. Due to the increased costs of material, Bill has requested an additional \$40,000 for asphalt repairs. After discussion, a motion was made, seconded, and carried to approve the additional \$40,000.

Ed reported that the Association is making progress with the on going SOD project. With the completion of SOD installment on Pollo in the early part of the year, we in in the process of installing about 15,000 square feet of SOD on Obra, Vera and a few other areas of the complex. This is an ongoing project.

SOLAR PROJECT

Andy with Tier Drop solar said that they finally have the permits to proceed with solar on the rec halls. They have tentatively schedule the disconnect for Caminito Baywood recreation hall on May 31st and the Flores recreation hall on June 7th.

LANDSCAPE

Karin asked the Board if the Association should pause the ongoing sod replacement project. The Board decided to complete the sod projects now under way. Going forward, we will evaluate water/drought conditions before starting new sod project.
