Republic Services offers different cart sizes to best fit your recycling and waste needs yearround:

35-gal cart 65-gal cart 94-gal cart

Placing carts for collection

Face carts toward the street with wheels against the curb or gutter the night before or by 7 a.m. on your scheduled service day. Allow at least 3 feet between carts and 6 feet between carts and other objects (mailboxes, trees, basketball hoops, cars, etc.). Make sure lids are securely shut - materials should not extend beyond the cart rim. Do not place hot ashes, dirt, rock, concrete or hazardous items in vour carts.

Reasons waste may not be collected:

- Overfilled or overweight cart
- ▶ Insufficient space to ▶ Car blocking cart service cart
- Unacceptable material in cart
- Cart too far from
- Cart facing the wrong direction

Know what to throw

When it comes to the blue recycling carts, always remember to keep materials empty, clean and dry.

Tips for Recycling:

- ▶ Aim to recycle clean materials that are not contaminated with food, oils, etc.
- If you are recycling cardboard, break down boxes so that they are flat. This will save you space in your cart for other recyclable materials and prevent overflowing carts.
- Make sure all liquids or other contents are removed from bottle or jugs.
- Never bag your recycling! Make sure all recyclables are LOOSE when they reach the carts that are serviced by our drivers.
- Refer to the list of recyclable items listed in this flyer if unsure.
