

**What is a Valid Mesa Village Pool Card?
Policy Effective Date 10/1/2013**



All MVHOA ID CARDS MUST HAVE A MATCHING PICTURE
The Person Named On The ID Card MUST Be Listed On The Resident List and Be At Least 14 Years Old

What can invalidate a Mesa Village Pool Card?

- If You are no longer listed as a unit resident. (*Homeowner updates his list and removes your name.*)
- If the ID does not pass the ID/Resident verification check when the staff/monitors are checking ID cards.
- The units privileges are suspended due to a disciplinary hearing held by the Board.

What do I need to do to get a Mesa Village Pool Card?

A Valid Mesa Village ID Card can be obtained easily but it can only be issued by the Mesa Village HOA Office. Our hours are M-F from 8AM-3PM. If you cannot make it during our office hours, please contact the office at 858-566-0244 or email mvhoa@mvhoa.org to make other arrangements. In order to be eligible for a pool card you must meet the following requirements. (*See Below*)

- You must be a resident of Mesa Village Homeowners Association.
(*The Homeowner of each unit is required to submit a list of names that they have delegated any rights to use and enjoy the properties.*) [Download Owner/Tenant Information Sheet](#)
- You must be 14 years of age or older.
(*Proof of age is required: CA ID, Military ID, Pass Port, some school ID have birth-dates*)
- Unit MUST be in good standing.
(*To be issued a Mesa Village Pool Card, the units privileges must not be suspended.*)
